The Snakes (Matthew 23:33)

What do you think about this positive action taken by the Pharisees recorded in verse 31?

In Jesus' day, there were at least 6 groups of Pharisees:

"The Shoulder Pharisees" - wore their good works on their shoulders, looking for recognition.

"The Wait-a-little Pharisees" - would wait till tomorrow the good they could do today.

The Bruised and Bleeding Pharisees" - walked with head down or eyes closed so they wouldn't look at a woman, and be tempted. So they ran into lots of walls!

"The Adding-Them-Up Pharisees" - kept a record of their good deeds.

"The Fearing Pharisees" - lived in and were motivated by fear of God.

"The God-Loving Pharisees" - lived in faith and love. They admired Jesus.

With what group do you identify with? Personally or in your own church experience?

The Fox - Herod

Read Mark 6:14-29 for a bit of context about Herod.

What do you think about Jesus criticizing a political leader by calling him a fox?

How does Jesus' actions inform us concerning our own political involvement?

The Hen - Jesus

What is this metaphor supposed to teach us about Jesus?

How do you feel about describing Jesus in female terms? Check out Deuteronomy 32:18.
